UNDERSTANDING SALVATION

Aug. 20-24	Romans 3:23	For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,
Aug. 27-31	John 1:12	But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God,
Sept. 4-7*	Isaiah 59:2	But your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, and your sins have hidden his face from you so that he does not hear.
Sept. 10-14	I John 5:11-12	And this is the testimony, that God gave us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life.
Sept. 17-21	Eph. 2:8-9	For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, ⁹ not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

KNOWING GOD

Sept. 24-28	Romans 8:9	You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him.
Oct. 1-5	I Cor. 2:12	Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might understand the things freely given us by God.
Oct. 8-11*	Psalms 95:6	Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before the LORD, our Maker!
Oct. 15-18*	Matt. 1:21	She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins.”
Oct. 22-26	Psalms 100:3	Know that the LORD, he is God! It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.

Oct. 29-Nov. 2	Hebrews 3:13	But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called “today,” that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin..
Nov. 5-9	John 16:24	Until now you have asked nothing in my name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full.
Nov. 12-16	Mark 1:35	And rising very early in the morning, while it was still dark, he departed and went out to a desolate place, and there he prayed.
Nov. 26-30	Psalms 5:3	O LORD, in the morning you hear my voice; in the morning I prepare a sacrifice for you and watch.
Dec. 3-7	Exodus 33:11	Thus the LORD used to speak to Moses face to face, as a man speaks to his friend. When Moses turned again into the camp, his assistant Joshua the son of Nun, a young man, would not depart from the tent.

Dec. 10-14 Mark 5:19 And he did not permit him but said to him, "Go home to your friends and tell them how much the Lord has done for you, and how he has had mercy on you.

Jan. 14-18 Psalm 91:14 "Because he holds fast to me in love, I will deliver him; I will protect him, because he knows my name."

Jan. 22-25* Psalm 91:11 For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways.

Jan. 28-Feb. 1 I Peter 5:7 Casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you.

Feb. 4-8 Phil. 4:7 And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
