NOTICE OF PROPOSED BYLAW AMENDMENT

With respect to the removal and resignation of officers of the Board, Article V, Section 6 of the CPLS Bylaws currently provides as follows: Any officer may be removed, either with or without cause, by a majority of the directors at the time in office, at any regular or special meeting of the Board, or, except in case of an officer chosen by the Board of Directors, by an officer upon whom such power of removal may be conferred by the Board of Directors.

For purposes of clarity, the Bylaws Committee is proposing to amend this provision to read as follows: Any officer may be removed, either with or without cause, by a majority of the directors present at any regular or special meeting of the Board.

If any parent or guardian of a CPLS student wishes to comment on this proposed bylaw amendment, you may do so by submitting your comment to Shari Albrecht by e-mail to smfalbrecht@cox.net or by U.S. mail to 3121 SW Tutbury Town Road, Topeka, KS 66614. The comment period ends on January 21, 2005, after which the proposed amendment will be submitted to the CPLS Board for adoption.

APOLOGETICS - One semester course studying arguments for the existence of God.
