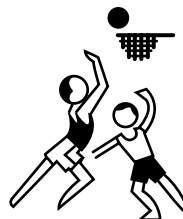

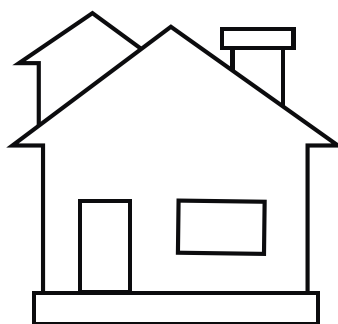

## TUITION ASSISTANCE DEADLINES

Tuition Assistance, formerly referred to as Financial Aid, is available to new and returning families based upon financial need. CPLS utilizes Family Financial Needs Assessment (FFNA), an objective third-party, to process the applications and assess each family's financial situation. FFNA accepts applications on-line or via USPS. Based on the processing times for each type of application and our goal to communicate awards to families by Friday, April 22, we have established the following deadlines:

Regular Processing, USPS, application & tax return must be received by FFNA by March 15, 2005 (Fee payable to FFNA \$20)

Regular Processing, on-line, application & tax return must be received by FFNA by March 29, 2005 (Fee payable to FFNA \$30)

Fastback Processing, on-line or USPS, application & tax return must be received by FFNA by April 8, 2005 (Fee payable to FFNA \$40)

Applications and brochures will be available starting February 19th at the State of the School Family Meeting. Funds available for Tuition Assistance and 2005-2006 tuition rates will be announced at this time.

Please note that a completed Federal Tax Return is required for all applications. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact Julie Funk.

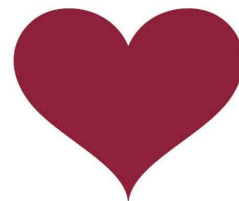

# PARENT TEACHER FELLOWSHIP MINUTES

## GENERAL MEETING

### SEPTEMBER 10, 2004

Those present: Cindy Cox, Cindy Patton, Deb Jorgensen, Marne Fischer, Tami Foster, Melissa French, Sandra Fienhage, Jaye Conner, Leanna Clark, Tammy Anderson, Darla Haas, Kim Coker, and Suzanne Kentch.

Cindy Cox called the meeting to order. Cindy Patton opened in prayer. The June, 2004 minutes were approved by consensus with a correction noted that the actual dollar amount from 2003 back to school parties credited back to the school was \$90.07 (not the previously reported \$86.74).

Treasurer's Report : Sandra presented the following reports: 2003/2004 Year End Report, June 2004 Cash Flow Statement, July 2004 Cash Flow Statement, and a PTF Proposed Budget and YTD Income/Expense Report. Cash Balance on hand as of 9/09/04 was \$3,503.32. Sandra suggested the outgoing, or current as the case may be Treasurer should prepare a Fiscal Year End report to be distributed at the fiscal year end. Sandra requested Jaye reconcile the checkbook for May, June, and July 2004. Jaye verified that the account was reconciled and correct to July 2004.

President Elect's Report: Marne presented a Wish List report detailing descriptions of all requests, by whom requested, dates items were purchased, and cost of individual requests. To date \$910.42 have been spent on Wish List items.

Secretary's Report: Jaye read several "thank you" cards from teachers and students. These were: Julie Conroy, Margie Brown, Sue Jernigan and her students, Iraida Orr, and Wendy Keller. Jaye presented a proposal for equipping the library with window shades to cut down on the glare. Leanna moved and Tami seconded to purchase shades for up to \$150.00 if the fundraiser netted more than \$4,500.00. Motion passed.

Volunteer Coordinator's Report: Darla reported on the Teachers Appreciation schedule for classrooms to provide "treats" in the lounge.

Old Business: The final expenses for Back to School parties for 2004 were \$327.27. Ideas were also discussed for distribution of fundraising prizes.

New Business: A request was received from Mr. Waldy for purchasing school spirit shirts for faculty at a cost of \$375.00. Motion passed. Cindy Patton requested help in replacing the upstairs back door at an approximate cost of \$1,000.00. A request was also received from Mrs. Simmons for replacement remotes for her dvd/vcr at an estimated cost of \$100.00. These issues were tabled until further research could be done and the final figures gathered on the net proceeds of the fundraiser.

The meeting adjourned until 3:45 p.m. at which time the new 2004/2005 budget was reviewed and approved by general consensus.

The next PTF meeting will be October 8, 2004 at 1:30 in the Daycare House at CP-LS.
