THE FIRST DEADLINE HAS PASSED

We have passed our first deadline for the tuition assistance application process, and USPS applications with regular processing will no longer be accepted. All applications submitted from this point forward must be submitted on-line, Fastback on-line, or Fastback USPS. The remaining due dates are as follows:

On-line* application with regular processing (\$30): RECEIVED by FFNA March 29, 2005.

On-line* application with Fastback processing (\$40): RECEIVED by FFNA April 8, 2005.

USPS application with Fastback processing (\$40): RECEIVED by FFNA April 8, 2005.

*Note: Tax returns must be mailed and RECEIVED by FFNA by these dates also.

The purpose of these deadlines is to allow us to communicate tuition assistance awards to families as soon as possible. All applications for returning families must be in for us to allocate the pool of funds available. 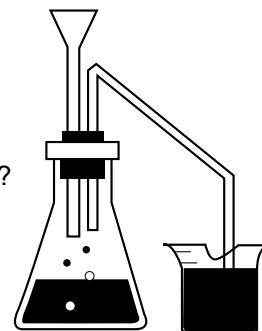

- 2) If your check is returned because of non-sufficient funds (NSF), you will be charged a \$30 fee payable to CPLS. After two NSF checks are tendered on your account, your Lions Share ordering privileges will be limited to money order only.
- 3) Lions Share certificates are purchased on your behalf, and are not returnable.
- 4) When you pick up or receive your certificates, open your order and verify its accuracy. In the unlikely event you should find a discrepancy in your order, please contact Cori Power, Lions Share Coordinator, within 7 days.
- 5) Certificates are the same as cash and should be handled accordingly. CPLS will not be responsible for certificates that are lost, stolen or misplaced while in your possession.
- 6) You must sign a WAIVER OF RESPONSIBILITY form before certificates will be mailed to you or released with your child. These forms will be kept on file, and CPLS accepts no responsibility for certificates delivered in this manner.
