GREAT IDEAS ADJUNCT NEEDED

One of the most interesting classes taught here at Cair Paravel-Latin School is the Great Ideas Seminar. Dave Schneider and Jim Congdon team teach that class for the Seniors. It is a discussion format class where students discuss Political or Moral Philosophy and read excerpts from some of the most noted Philosophers from Western Civilization. They compare and contrast the "Great Ideas" of the ages with current trends in thought.
