CPLS MENS SOCCER TEAM WINS KCAA STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

For the fourth year in a row, the CPLS Men's Varsity soccer team is KCAA state champions!

The Lion's received a first round bye and played Flint Hills Christian School in the second round and won 1-0. (Shots on goal: CPLS - 29, Saves: Marcus - 2, Keller - 1.) Flint Hills gave the Mighty Lions a good game. The Lions had many shots but could only muster one goal. That seemed to be enough as FHCS played in their end most of the game.

CPLS advanced to the championship game against WAHAA Warriors of Wichita. CPLS lost to WAHAA in our first game of the season 3-1 and came into this championship looking to avenge this early season loss. The game was exciting and the pace was furious. The score was 0-0 at halftime. With about 30 minutes left to play Greyson Honaker scored on an assist from Craig Congdon. Momentum changed however with about 10 minutes left in the match as WAHAA scored to even the contest. Regulation time expired with both teams even at one goal each. We started play in the first overtime period playing very well and scoring late in the first overtime to seal the win on a fantastic goal from Craig Congdon assisted by John Stamm.

Junior Craig Congdon, Freshman Greyson Honaker, Sophomore John Stamm, and Senior Griff Letch were selected as all tournament players. This concluded a great season for our soccer team finishing at 14-5-2.

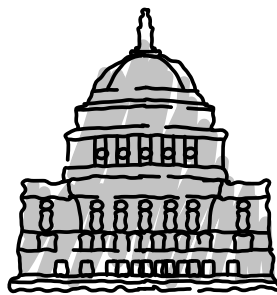
BASKETBALL PARENT INFORMATION MEETING

The 7th & 8th grade boys basketball coach has scheduled several optional practices over the next four weeks. All interested 7th & 8th grade boys are invited to attend.

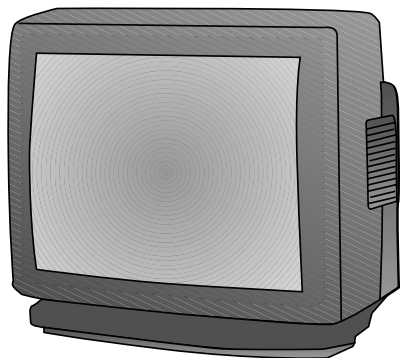

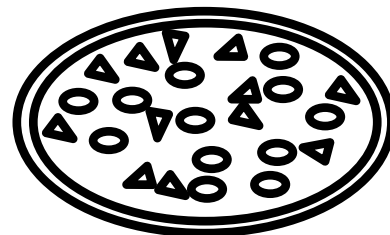
