CPLS SENIORS NAMED NATIONAL MERIT SCHOLARS

Cair Paravel-Latin School congratulates its two National Merit Finalists, Rebekah Meek and Sam Schneider. The National Merit Scholarship Program announced its finalists February 2, 2004.

The National Merit® Scholarship Program is an academic competition for recognition and scholarships that began in 1955. High school students enter the National Merit Program by taking the PSAT/NMSQT® and by meeting published program entry/participation requirements. The test serves as an initial screen of approximately 1.3 million entrants each year.



All winners of Merit Scholarship® awards (Merit Scholar® designees) will be chosen from the Finalist group, based on their abilities, skills, and accomplishments.

The criteria for selection to receive a Merit Scholarship® includes the finalists academic record, information about the school's curricula and grading system, two sets of test scores, school recommendation, information about the student's activities and leadership, and the Finalist's own essay.

Rebekah is the daughter of Craig and Letty Meek. Sam is the son of Dave and Lisa Schneider.

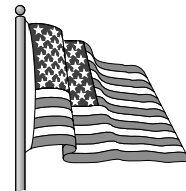

eligibility for financial aid.

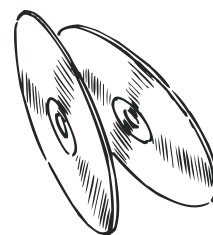

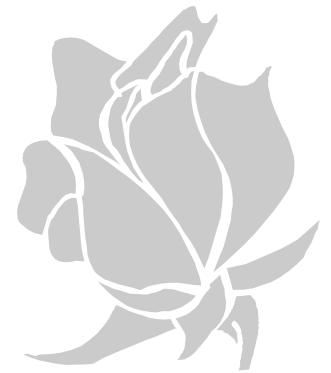
