ASLAN LECTURE SERIES

David Wright is our featured speaker for the Aslan Lecture scheduled for March 9, 2004. He will speak in the Stone Table Theatre at 7:00 p.m. on the topic of "Christianity and the Creative Process". He will be elaborating on what the church and artists need from each other. He thinks the church can benefit from the creativity of writers and artists. Artists can benefit learning to live in community with the church.

Mr. Wright has an undergraduate minor in music and has been collaborating with classical composer James Clemens, including choral pieces on the parable of the mustard seed and the Samaritan woman at the well. Wright will send a choral piece of music to our music department and our Madrigals will perform the piece on March 9 at the lecture.

On March 10, Mr. Wright will work with a master class of writers on writing poetry.

Mr. Wright is interested in how writers and artists relate to the Christian community. He is a member of the Mennonite church and teaches writing and literature at Wheaton College.
