### RE-ENROLLMENT AND FINANCIAL AID PACKETS DEADLINE MARCH 15

Please watch for re-enrollment forms that will be coming in the mail next week. Re-enrollment forms need to be back in the office by March 15, 2004. There is a \$50.00 charge for re-enrolling your family. That fee will be refunded if you recommend a new family to CPLS who ends up being enrolled. After March 15, the enrollment fee is \$75.00 for a family.

#### FINANCIAL AID

Financial aid may also be available to your family. Financial aid awards are processed by an independent agency, FFNA, who confidentially evaluates the financial status of a family that may need help in paying tuition. Applications for financial aid need to be received by FFNA by March 15. If you mail your financial aid packets by March 10, they should be received by FFNA by March 15th. FFNA charges for mailed applications are \$20.00. If you apply online, FFNA charges are \$30.00.

As stated at the family meeting last Saturday, the Board has increased the total financial aid available to families from \$38,000 to \$50,000. Pick up a financial aid application from Jane Unruh in

### UNIFORM COMMITTEE WILL ADD NEW VENDORS

Effective **June 1, 2004**, Spirit of the Game will no longer be the exclusive vendor for our uniforms. After extensive review of parent opinion, vendor options and pricing, the uniform committee recommended that we not renew our exclusive contract with Spirit of the Game to provide our uniforms.

Instead, beginning June 1, 2004, our families will have the option of buying their Royal Park and A+ uniforms at Worland's or Spirit of the Game and a third vendor, Sunflower Marketing. Details about the other uniform options will be made available as those decisions are made. It is the consensus of the uniform committee, the administration and the parent and student uniform surveys received that broad

### ASLAN LECTURE

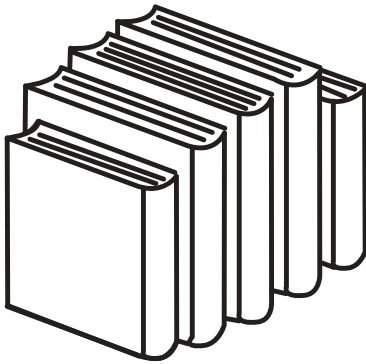
In case this series is new to you, I will quote comments made in The Vision Forum catalog:

the business office and submit the application to FFNA. Make sure you have your taxes prepared by that date as 2003 income tax information will be used to determine eligibility for financial aid.

### APPLICATION FOR FINANCIAL AID GUIDELINES:

You are the person who funds the tuition for your students.

Your 2003 AGI is less than 42k or if your tuition bill is approximately 10% (or more) of your AGI.

Meeting these guidelines does not automatically qualify you for aid. They are only guidelines, and several other factors are considered.

At a special budget session in January, the Board did rescind a policy in place for about 7 years. New families to our school will now be eligible for aid the first year. Previously they had to pay undiscounted tuition for their child the first year. These awards to new families will be in addition to the budget, so this policy change should not harm current families, but will bring new students who could then be at our school for several years. We hope that the availability of aid will remove a barrier to some families for whom the first year aid will enable them to choose to send their child to CPLS.

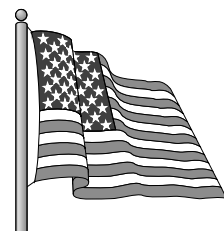
