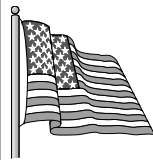

## ANNA WALDY SCORES AS NATIONAL MERIT SEMI-FINALIST

Anna Waldy, daughter of James and Tami Waldy, recently received news that she was selected as a national merit semi-finalist. Anna achieved this honor by taking the PSAT her junior year and being among the highest scoring entrants in Kansas for 2007 graduates. Fewer than 1 percent of high school seniors in the country are represented on the semi-finalist list, which was released last week by the National Merit Scholarship Corp.

Anna will now compete for finalist status. To advance to the finalist level, semifinalists must have a strong academic record, be recommended by the school principal and submit a detailed scholarship application.

Anna continues a trend at CPLS, which has had a student recognized by the National Merit Scholarship program for 15 consecutive years!
