Senior volleyball players are Hillary Caywood, Brianne Clark and Jessica Toth.

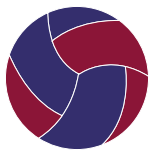
### FOOTBALL

**Quid:** National Junior Classical League is an organization of middle and high school students founded in 1936. Its purpose is to encourage an interest in and an appreciation of the language, literature and culture of ancient Greece and Rome and to impart an understanding of the debt of our own culture to that of Classical antiquity.

Our chapter will meet regularly (frequency to be determined) to read about and discuss different aspects of classical culture and enjoy the camaraderie of fellow classical enthusiasts.

**Quis:** Any Latin student grades 6-12 who has at least a “C” average in Latin may apply.

**Quomodo:** Fill out the application form and write a brief statement (about 100 words) detailing why you want to be a member of the Junior Classical League.

**Ubi:** The deadline for application for the 2006-2007 school year is *ante diem XIII Kalendas November* (October 20).

**Quanti:** The cost is for membership is \$2.00 per member. T-shirts will also be available at a small cost (purchase is encouraged but not required).
