Quick idea: Egg in a Basket – Cover a frying pan with no-fat cooking spray. Tear a hole out of a slice of whole-wheat bread, put the slice in the pan, and crack an egg into the hole. Cook two minutes, flip, and cook until the egg is set and lightly browned. Have fun!

BOXTOPS FOR EDUCATION

Thanks to all the families and friends who helped CPLS earn \$460 last year simply by clipping Box Tops off of grocery items. Many local schools do a great job of emphasizing this program and encouraging participation. Here are some local top-earning schools from last year according to the Box Tops website.

- * Corpus Christi Catholic school in Lawrence (approx 400 students) \$1,393
- * Silver Lake Elementary in Silver Lake (approx. 370 students) \$1,391
- * Berryton Elementary in Berryton (approx 370 students) \$1,014
- * Most Pure Heart in Topeka (approx 470 students) \$ 833

The average school within 25 miles of our campus earned \$272. CPLS ranked 82nd out of the 107 schools that participate in the Box Tops program within that 25 mile radius.

Clipping Box Tops is such an easy way to earn money for our school. Over the past few years, PTF has used more than \$2200 earned from Box Tops to help fulfill teachers' wish lists for classroom supplies.

Quid: National Junior Classical League is an organization of middle and high school students founded in 1936. Its purpose is to encourage an interest in and an appreciation of the language, literature and culture of ancient Greece and Rome and to impart an understanding of the debt of our own culture to that of Classical antiquity.

Our chapter will meet regularly (frequency to be determined) to read about and discuss different aspects of classical culture and enjoy the camaraderie of fellow classical enthusiasts.

Quis: Any Latin student grades 6-12 who has at least a “C” average in Latin may apply.

Quomodo: Fill out the application form and write a brief statement (about 100 words) detailing why you want to be a member of the Junior Classical League.

Ubi: The deadline for application for the 2006-2007 school year is *ante diem XIII Kalendas November* (October 20).

Quanti: The cost is for membership is \$2.00 per member. T-shirts will also be available at a small cost (purchase is encouraged but not required).
