## TALKING POINT #2: ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

- CPLS students place in the top 2% of Iowa Basic Test Scores (elementary) nationwide.
- The CPLS average ACT test score is 26, compared with a statewide average of 21.8 and a national average of 21.1.
- CPLS boasts 15 National Merit Scholarship finalists, 2 semi-finalists and 25 commended scholars in its short 26 year history, with at least one student recognized each year since 1993.
- CPLS students are accepted and attend a wide-range of colleges and universities through-out the country.

## TUITION ASSISTANCE FOR 2007-08 SCHOOL YEAR

Tuition Assistance will again be available to new and returning families based upon financial need; most families qualify with either: 1) "adjusted gross income" under \$42,000, or 2) tuition greater than 10% of "adjusted gross income".

CPLS utilizes Family Financial Needs Assessment (FFNA), an objective third party, to process the applications and assess each family's financial situation. We will then divide the Tuition Assistance funds available, based upon FFNA's recommendations, among those families who qualify in time to be considered. In order to apply for tuition assistance for the 2007-2008 school year, families must have their 2006 Federal Income Tax Return completed by the application deadline.

Based on the processing times for each type of application and our goal to communicate awards to families by Monday, April 23, we have established the following deadlines:

Regular Processing, USPS, application & tax return must be received by FFNA by March 2, 2007 (Fee payable to FFNA \$20)

Regular Processing, on-line, application & tax return must be received by FFNA by March 16, 2007 (Fee payable to FFNA \$30)

Fastback Processing, on-line or USPS, application & tax return must be received by FFNA by March 30, 2007 (Fee payable to FFNA \$40)

Applications are available now from Shirley Price in the business office; if you apply on-line ([www.ffna1.com](http://www.ffna1.com)) you will not need a paper application form. You may want to visit FFNA's web site for general information about the application process. If you have any other questions regarding tuition assistance, please contact Shirley (or Bob Hannibal) at the school.

## AFTER-SCHOOL MONITOR NEEDED

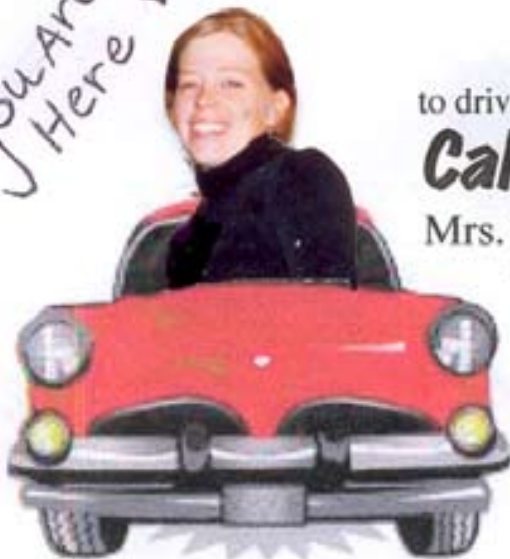

Thank you for all your prayers and support for the high school Spiritual Emphasis Week. It was a huge success!

We had speakers from the Rescue Mission, Let's Help, Crisis Pregnancy Center, Meals on Wheels, Battered Women's Shelter and the Police Department. The speakers educated the students on their agencies from Monday through Wednesday. Thursday and Friday the students were involved in actually doing service projects in some of these very same agencies as well as many more. The students found themselves doing everything from cleaning toys and polishing pews to singing with retarded citizens and hosting a tea party for some elderly shut-ins. We had 18 different projects both days. I have received many thank you notes and many words of praise for our students from different agencies. I've posted some of them on the upstairs bulletin board.

Thanks to the whole school for participating in the canned and paper products drive. We collected 347 cans, 121 dry goods, 20 rolls of paper towel, 171 rolls of toilet paper, 280 personal hygiene products and 68 general merchandise items. We also made 10 knitted baby hats, 6 fleece blankets, prepared 12 dinner meals and put 12 gallons of paint on walls.
