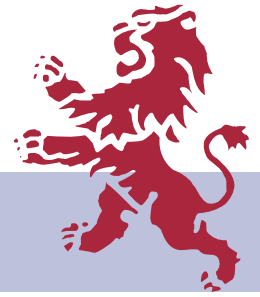

NEW CHIEF ADMINISTRATOR SELECTED

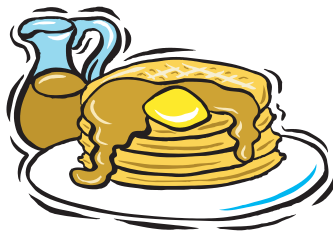

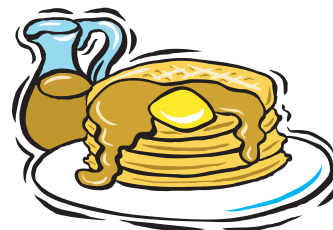

TUITION ASSISTANCE – ONLY 2 MORE WEEKS

If you are planning on applying for Tuition Assistance for the 2007-08 school year, but have not yet done so, please note that you have one last chance!

Tuition Assistance is available to new and returning families based upon financial need; most families qualify with either: 1) "adjusted gross income" less than \$42,000, or 2) tuition greater than 10% of "adjusted gross income". CPLS utilizes Family Financial Needs Assessment (FFNA), an objective third party, to process the applications and assess each family's financial situation. In order to apply for tuition assistance for the 2007-2008 school year, families must have their 2006 Federal Tax Return completed by the application deadline.

While the "Regular Processing" deadlines have now passed, you still have about two weeks to apply using the last option: Fastback Processing, on-line or USPS, application & tax return must be received by FFNA by March 30, 2007 (Fee payable to FFNA \$40)

Applications are available now from Shirley Price in the business office; if you apply on-line (www.ffna1.com) you will not need a paper application form. Our goal is to communicate awards to families by Monday, April 23. You may want to visit FFNA's web site for general information about the application process. If you have any other questions regarding tuition assistance, please contact Shirley (or Bob Hannibal) at the school. Don't wait until the "last minute" for forms or information; the school offices will be closed for Spring Break the last week of March!
