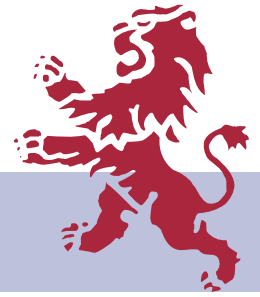

Desperate to escape their father's plan, and to marry for love instead of money, Cleante and Elise wangle to subvert Harpagon's tightfisted arrangements.
