SCRIP FUND-RAISING PROGRAM**

Lions Share is a fundraising program by which CPLS families and friends may support the operations of the school by using "scrip" gift cards sold by the school to make their regular purchases.

Proceeds from the Lions Share program benefit the CPLS general fund and help keep tuition rates down.

If all of our 200 CPLS families participated on a regular basis, purchasing an average of \$400 of Lions Share cards on a monthly basis, we could raise over \$48,000 for the school. And all you have to do is buy groceries using scrip!

It's a painless way to support the school spending money you would be spending anyway to purchase gas, groceries, clothing, movie tickets and meals at your favorite restaurant.

**8TH ANNUAL CPLS

The 8th Annual CPLS Golf Classic and Inaugural 5K and 1-mile Run/Walk event was held on Saturday, August 25th. The events were a great success, blessed by terrific weather and a great turnout.

24 teams (96 golfers) participated in the golf event. Approximately 85 runners participated in the 5K Run and 60 walkers for the 1-mile run/walk, not counting the number of runners who participated in both running events.

The event raised over \$10,000 for the CPLS Athletic Department and CPLS Facilities Fund.

NEW RENWEB LOG IN

Renweb, our grade and attendance student information communication software, has added an additional feature. Renweb now offers a new login page that is linked directly to our website that will have our school code imbedded in the page so you won't have to reenter the district code each time you visit. This new login page can also remember e-mail addresses in the form of a cookie on a user's computer to make everyday login friendly and easy by only requiring a password. Users can select whether or not they want their email addresses remembered in case multiple users share that computer.

You must first access Renweb directly from our CPLS website at www.cpls.org. (You may find the link under OUTREACH on our home page.) It will direct you to the CPLS log in page. You may then bookmark it in your internet browser for future use.

If you are not at your home computer, or if you choose to access Renweb directly at www.renweb.com, you will have to enter the district code, email address and password.

- 1) All certificate orders must be accompanied by a check or money order made payable to CPLS. Lions Share certificate payments are not tax deductible because you receive dollar for dollar value.
- 2) If your check is returned because of non-sufficient funds (NSF), you will be charged a \$30 fee payable to CPLS. After two NSF checks are tendered on your account, your Lions Share ordering privileges will be limited to money order only.
- 3) Lions Share certificates are purchased on your behalf, and are not returnable.
- 4) When you pick up or receive your certificates, open your order and verify its accuracy. In the unlikely event you should find a discrepancy in your order, please contact Shirley Price, Lions Share coordinator, within seven days.
- 5) Certificates are the same as cash, and should be handled accordingly. CPLS will not be responsible for certificates that are lost, stolen or misplaced while in your possession.
- 6) You must sign a WAIVER OF RESPONSIBILITY form before certificates will be mailed to you or released with your child. These forms will be kept on file, and CPLS accepts no responsibility for certificates delivered in this manner.
