The PSAT/NMSQT Examination will be given Wednesday, October 17, 8:00 a.m. at CPLS. To register your student, make a check for \$13.00 payable to CPLS and place it in Mrs. Congdon's box. *(Please note that the amount was reported incorrectly in last week's newsletter.)*

PSAT/NMSQT stands for Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test. It's a standardized test that provides firsthand practice for the SAT Reasoning Test™. Students scores (in grade 11 only) may qualify them to enter National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) scholarship programs.

All juniors should take this test.

- 6) You must sign a WAIVER OF RESPONSIBILITY form before certificates will be mailed to you or released with your child. These forms will be kept on file, and CPLS accepts no responsibility for certificates delivered in this manner.
