ACT SCORES ARE IN!

We are happy to report that the ACT scores for Cair Paravel were revealed on July 26th of this summer, and our students have improved in each and every academic category. CPLS students continue to score much higher than our government school counterparts.

Here are the latest numbers...

Cair Paravel's overall composite score was 25.8, up from the 24.4 achieved a year ago, and over 4 points higher than the 21.7 achieved by the state schools.

The subject areas are broken into four categories. Here are the results in each area.

English	CPLS - 26.6	State - 21.2
Mathematics	CPLS - 24.6	State - 21.4
Reading	CPLS - 27.4	State - 22.1
Science	CPLS - 25.8	State - 21.7

May this be a year of continued improvement and strong academic excellence.

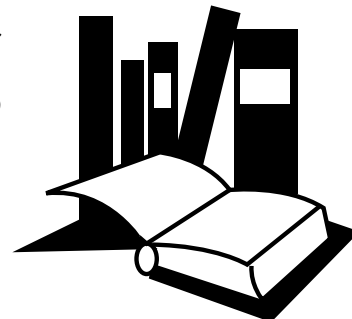

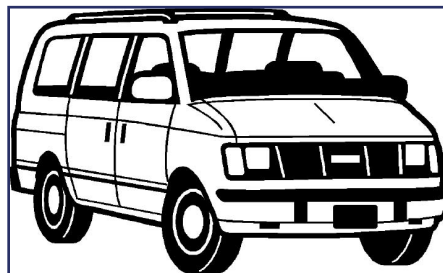

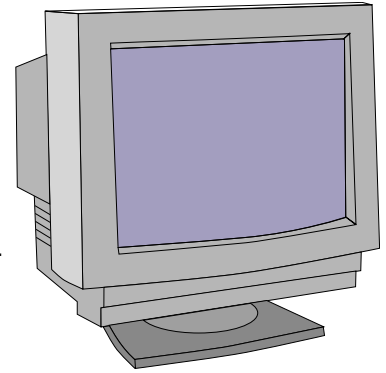

- 1) All certificate orders must be accompanied by a check or money order made payable CPLS. Please do not send cash. Lions Share certificate payments are not tax deductible because you receive dollar for dollar value.
- 2) If your check is returned because of non-sufficient funds (NSF), you will be charged a \$30 fee payable to CPLS. After two NSF checks are tendered on your account, your Lions Share ordering privileges will be limited to money order only.
- 3) Lions Share certificates are purchased on your behalf, and are not returnable.
- 4) When you pick up or receive your certificates, open your order and verify its accuracy. In the unlikely event you should find a discrepancy in your order, please contact Cori Power, Lions Share Coordinator, within 7 days.
- 5) Certificates are the same as cash and should be handled accordingly. CPLS will not be responsible for certificates that are lost, stolen or misplaced while in your possession.
- 6) You must sign a WAIVER OF RESPONSIBILITY form before certificates will be mailed to you or released with your child. These forms will be kept on file, and CPLS accepts no responsibility for certificates delivered in this manner.
